Godly Mothers

Zac Hall

Since today is Mother's Day, we want to take time to look at godly mothers. If we stopped and thought about great mothers of the Bible who would you think of. The very first mother I think of is the very first mother that ever lived. Eve was created in the beginning. Eve means life, she was is the mother all living Genesis 3:20. One might also think about Sarah because of her age when she gave birth. Another great mother that comes to mind is Jocabed – Moses' mother instead of killing Moses, she saved him. Of course, Mary the mother of Jesus is often talked about when mothers are involved. I want to consider two mothers that we may not always think about. Lois and Eunice 2 Timothy 1:3-5. Look at three lesson in which one can learn from these two ladies.

Godly Mothers have Faith. (2 Timothy 1:3-5)

This faith brings Joy. Paul was joyful when he remembered the faith of Lois and Eunice 2 Timothy 1:5. Doesn't it bring you joy when you see faithful mothers and grandmothers that bring their children to church and teach them about God? When one examines the Bible, they can find other great examples of faithful mothers. Ruth was faithful to God and to her mother in law. No doubt this faithfulness would have carried over into her role as a mother. (Ruth 1:16-17). One might also consider the faithfulness Rahab (James 2:25). Both of these two ladies have the privilege of being in the genealogy of Christ (Matt 1). All of these mothers serve as a great example for mothers today. It is very critical that mothers today are founded in the truth. Children are always watching their parents especially mom.

Godly Mothers Teach Their Own Children. (2 Timothy 1:5, 3:14-15).

Mothers have the great responsibility to teach their children. It is so important that children are taught about God from their youth. It is also important that this teaching comes from the parents. Paul understood the things Timothy knew he had learned from his childhood. (2 Tim 3:14-15). In the letter to Timothy He told Timothy to rely on that teaching. In the Bible there is other examples of teaching mothers. Mary would have taught Jesus (Luke 2:41ff). The apostle John was glad to hear about the faithful children of the elect lady in 2 John. This implies that this elect lady was teaching her children the way of God.

This idea goes along with what the proverb writer records in Proverbs 22:6 - Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.

Godly Mothers Teach Other Mothers. (Titus 2:3-5).

When Paul wrote to the evangelist Titus, he instructed him in some things in which women were to teach other. They were to be teachers of good things; these would be the things that are pleasing and acceptable to God. They were to teach younger women; this would be helping the next generation to be godly mothers. They were to teach them to love own husband. They were to teach them to love children; this would have included teaching the children about the ways of God. Although Lois and Eunice are not mentioned here, they would have done these things.

In Lois and Eunice, we have a great example of a godly mother and grandmother. There are many lessons one can learn from them. At the very least they were Christians who put God first in their lives and in the lives of their children.
