# Faithful Fathers

Today is the national holiday Father's Day. What does it mean to be a good father? How can one know if they are being a good father? The only way we can know for sure is by looking at the one and only standard on the home, The Bible. The Bible tells us several things about fathers and the roles in which they have been given by God. One of the things it tells us is that fathers are to be the spiritual leaders of the home. Sadly, in today's day and age this doesn't happen as it should. Consider for a time some faithful fathers and know that we can have faithful fathers today. Note the words of the proverb writer "The righteous *man* walks in his integrity; His children *are* blessed after him." Proverbs. 20:7

## Noah

If we look at the life of Noah, we can see the type of man he was and the type of father he was. Noah found grace in the eyes of God (Genesis 6:8). In a world where wickedness was everywhere. Noah lived for and chose to put God first in His life. The Bible says, "He walked with God" (Genesis 6:9). Noah was a man of faith and he practiced and preached righteousness (2 Peter 2:5). So, what about Noah being a Father. We don't have a verse that tell us exactly about the parenting style of Noah, but he served as a great example for His sons. The Bible tells us that his three sons were obedient and were saved from the flood (Genesis 7:7). Noah would have used his godly traits as a father

## Joshua

Consider Joshua the man. He was a man that trusted in God even when the majority did not (Numbers 14:6-9). Joshua was a man of action when it came to the commands of God (Joshua 1:1-11). Joshua chose God and also made sure that his family was choosing God (Joshua 24:15). Joshua was a man that cared about his household and he would train them in a way where God was pleased.

## Joseph (Jesus' Earthly Father).

When talking to religious people they sometimes want to elevate the earthly parents of Christ. It is not my intent to do this however one can examine these individuals and see the parents they were. Joseph was called a just man this would have be just in the eye of God or just according to the standard (Matthew 1:19). Since he was just that means he was also obedient to the law of God (Luke 2:21; 39). Joseph was also a worker who provided for his family (Mark 6:3). Joseph would have taken these traits of being a godly person and translated it to being a godly father.

So, the question becomes how do we get fathers like this? There is such an easy answer to this question. We follow the example before us. We use the Bible as the standard in our lives and the standard in our home (Colossians 3:17). We make sure that we put God first in our lives (Matthew 6:33). Our children are always watching us and what is important to us will be important to them. We must teach our children about God and His ways (Proverbs 22:6).
